Louisiana Oncology Society and Mississippi Society of Oncology are ready to help your practice communicate with patients, staff, caregivers and other physicians during a hurricane or other disaster.

LAoncologysociety.org has a message board which allows certain people from each oncology practice in Louisiana and Mississippi to post information about practice closures, temporary phone numbers, office relocations, and information about when and where offices will reopen.

We are asking for email addresses for two key contacts at each office. Patients and other physicians will be able to email them about treatment issues. The emails are confidential and not accessible to anyone viewing the message board.

We are collecting information about key contacts at each office (physician, practice administrator or other designee).

Those contacts will be given a password and access to the message board to post and/or change relevant information.

We are also collecting cell phone numbers so LOS staff can contact the key contacts at each office even when the internet is down in your area. We discovered during Ike and Gustav that text messaging works even when regular cell phone calls do not go through.

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All oncology practices in Louisiana and Mississippi are eligible to participate in the message board whether or not they are members of Louisiana Oncology Society or Mississippi Society of Oncology.

We will conduct a test of the message board with just key contacts in order for us to iron out any issues. Afterward we will provide information for practices to educate patients and caregivers about where to go for information during a disaster.

We will also share information about the message board with media, local and state emergency responders, other agencies, and other medical associations in nearby states.
